Illovo Sugar (South Africa) (Pty) Ltd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Illovo Sugar Africa, is one of the three largest sugar producers in the country which sources more than 90% of its annual cane throughput from large, medium and small-scale farmers. The company annually produces around 500 000 tons of brown and refined sugar for domestic market sales under the "Trusted Quality" brand, and manufactures the downstream products of furfural and its derivatives, ethyl alcohol, lactulose and syrup which are sold locally and to a wide range of export markets. 79% of its own energy requirements are generated from renewable fuels.
