Zambia Sugar Plc is the country's largest sugar producer and also Africa's single-biggest cane sugar factory on the African continent with a total annual sugar production capacity of around 445 000 tons. Listed on the Lusaka Stock Exchange, Illovo Sugar Africa owns 75% of the company which focuses on supplying domestic and regional markets, producing a wide range of sugar products, including syrup, under its Whitespoon brand. The company itself cultivates around 1.7 million tons of cane with the balance of around 1.6 million tons delivered by large and small-scale growers. 96% of its own energy requirements are generated from renewable fuels.
